

To reach the check-in for the Puerto Rico Offroad UTV Experience put this address into your GPS:

MEETING TIMES

- Session meets at 8:00 am. Tour starts at 8:30 am and finishes approximately at 10:30 am.
- Session meets at 10:00 am. Tour starts at 10:30 am and finishes approximately at 1:00 pm.
- Session meets at 1:00 pm. Tour starts at 1:30 pm and finishes approximately at 3:30 pm.

IMPORTANT: Please be advised that we meet half-hour before the actual tour happens.

During this time you can buy water, bandanas or goggles in the check-in souvenir shop, use the bathrooms, buy a non-alcoholic beverage at the bar and receive the off-road tour safety chat.

WHAT TO BRING

Customers are recommended to bring sneakers with good traction, comfortable shorts or pants, fanny pack, hand sanitizer, protective eye wear (REQUIRED), bug repellent, change of clothes, physical credit card used to pay for the tour, Photo ID (REQUIRED) and drivers license for the person driving the UTV vehicle. Customers can purchase goggles, face masks and bandanas at the checkin area's souvenir shop.

WAIVER FORMS

To make your check-in process MUCH FASTER and efficient, please copy & paste the waiver link that will be emailed to you into a new browser window, click on YES, put a checkmark in ACCEPTANCE and submit as soon as possible.

Make sure to send the waiver link to all the participants in your group.

You and all the participants in your group must accept the waiver online before arrival.

IMPORTANT: To make the waiver link work you need to copy & paste into a new browser window. Waivers for minors must be filled out upon arrival.

DIRECTIONS FROM SAN JUAN

(Going east - Approximate 15 to 20-minute drive, depending on your location and on traffic):

Take Baldorioty Avenue (#26) East ("Este") from San Juan to Carolina. Baldorioty Avenue runs parallel with the main airport. Approximately 2-3 minutes after you pass the airport you will see a construction site on your right, then get off on Roberto Sanchez Vilella Avenue exit, continue to the 2nd Exit 12B (also known as Campo Rico Avenue East - "Este") and go over the bridge. (HINT: Follow the Museo del Niño brown signs.) Continue all the way straight, pass 5 traffic lights to the end and you'll see the entrance of Hacienda Campo Rico.

Once you enter through the guarded gate you'll make a right turn, then the road leads you to the left, and then make a right in the intersection. Continue straight and after the lagoon on your right, you'll see a terracotta-colored house where you can park. Follow the stairs up to the Mojito Bar where you will find Ecoadventure Ziplinings check-in kiosk.

IMPORTANT NOTES

If taking a taxi or Uber, please coordinate your transportation as soon as possible. Do not wait until the last minute to coordinate your own transportation because taxi and Uber drivers run scarce in Puerto Rico. Please be advised that If you do not find transport at the last minute and you do not make it to the tour we do not provide any refunds. Please make sure the taxi or Uber driver drops you off at the Mojito Bar check-in area inside the Hacienda Campo Rico. Be advised that some Uber drivers will not want to enter the Hacienda Campo Rico; please make sure ahead of time that Uber or taxi driver agrees to enter the hacienda and drop you off at the Mojito Bar check-in area. If you are driving your own vehicle to the Hacienda Campo Rico you will find a designated area with plenty of free parking.
